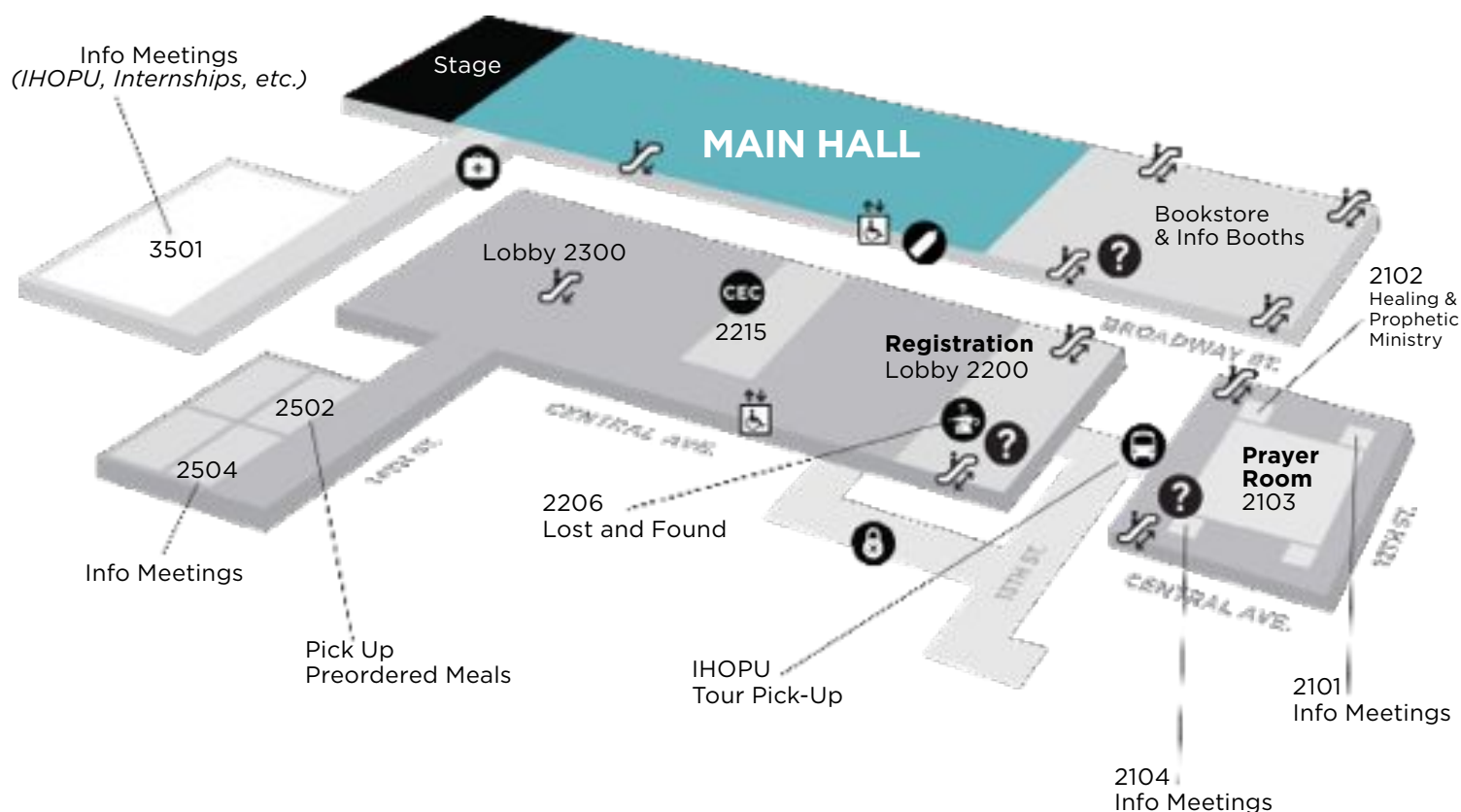

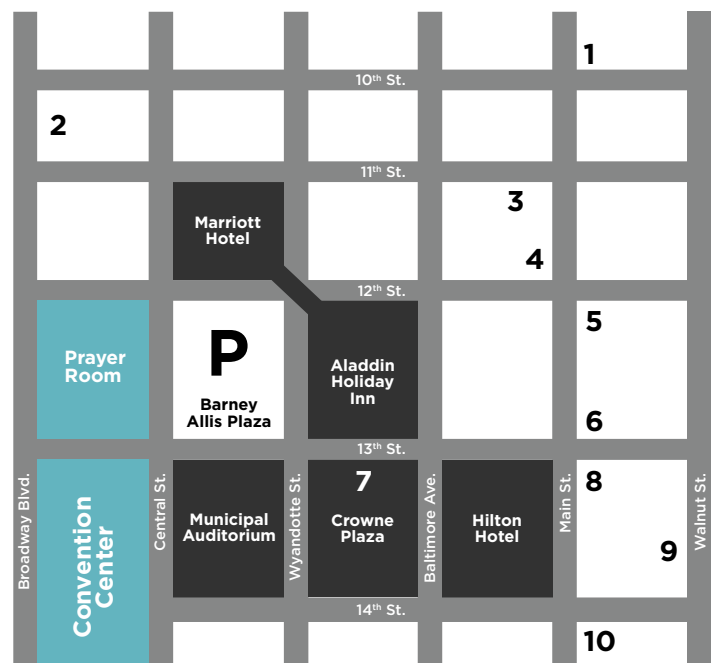

24/7 Worship with Prayer and 24/7 Works of Justice



The International House of Prayer Missions Base is an evangelical missions organization that is committed to praying for the release of the fullness of God's power and purpose, as we actively win the lost, heal the sick, feed the poor, make disciples, and impact society (family, education, government, economy, arts, media, religion, etc.).

Our vision is to work in relationship with the wider Body of Christ to serve the Great Commission, as we seek to walk out the two great commandments to love God and people.

On May 7, 1999, the International House of Prayer was founded by Mike Bickle and twenty full-time "intercessory missionaries," who cried out to God in prayer with worship for thirteen hours each day. Four months later, on September 19, 1999, our prayer and worship expanded to the full 24/7 schedule.

We refer to our full-time staff as "intercessory missionaries." They raise their own support to work as full-time

missionaries who reach out to others from a lifestyle of prayer and worship. Today, about 2,000 believers (staff, students, and interns) serve full-time, investing fifty hours per week as they go from the prayer room to the classroom and then to ministry outreaches and works of service.

Also, as those who are committed to the forerunner message, we are preparing ourselves to spiritually equip others for the unique dynamics of the generation in which the Lord returns.

On September 19, 2009, while celebrating our tenth anniversary together, we made a sober commitment before God to **combine 24/7 prayers for justice with 24/7 works of justice** until the Lord returns. Outreach has always been a vital part of our mission.

However, at that time, we set our heart to significantly increase our outreach and ministry to others. We are developing many outreach ministries that will continue 24/7 alongside our 24/7 prayer with worship.

Our ministries and outreaches include increasing our current inner-city outreach, Hope City, with on-site food distribution, discipleship programs, provision of food and clothing for children's outreaches, street clean-up, and a prayer room operating in the inner city ten hours every day, working towards night-and-day prayer.

Other outreaches include Hannah's Dream Adoptions and Children's Justice Initiative to serve orphans and children at risk, and Exodus Cry, helping victims of human trafficking. We are partnering with Women's Life Center, a local crisis pregnancy center helping women who refuse abortion and choose life. We plan to provide homes and restoration programs for victims of human trafficking and domestic violence and for prostitutes who respond to the gospel.

We are better equipped to reach out to others when our lives are rooted in prayer that focuses on intimacy with God and intercession for a breakthrough of the fullness of God's power and purpose for this generation.

International House of Prayer University (IHOPU) is for students who long to encounter Jesus and grow in the knowledge and love of God.

As part of the International House of Prayer, our Bible school is built on the centrality of the Word and 24/7 prayer with worship, equipping students in the Word and the power of the Spirit for the bold proclamation of the Lord Jesus and His kingdom.

Training at IHOPU forms not only minds but also lifestyle and character, to sustain students for a life of obedience, humility, and service in the kingdom.

With schools of ministry, music, media, and missions, our one- to four-year programs prepare students for ministry to serve the Great Commission and obey Jesus' commandments to love God and people.

School of MINISTRY

Bringing together theological training in the classroom, intimacy with Jesus, and ministry outreach

At Forerunner School of Ministry, theological education obtained in the classroom is deeply connected to intimacy with Jesus, practical service, outreach, works of justice, and acts of compassion.

The curriculum combines in-depth biblical study with practical discipleship and mentoring through an effective small group structure.

One- and two-year certificates and four-year diploma prepare students for ministry in all areas.

Our desire is to see every student disciplined through regular interaction with leaders and fellow students as they reach for the fullness of God's destiny for their lives.

School of MUSIC

Training singers and musicians in intercessory worship that reflects the worth of Christ and releases the power of God

Forerunner Music Academy (FMA) equips prophetic singers, musicians, and worship leaders in prophetic worship.

Musical training consists of skill development, theory, ear training, improvisation, and sound production. Students also receive hands-on coaching in a prayer room environment.

Training at FMA combines excellent musicianship with intimacy with Jesus, and prepares students to fill houses of prayer, local congregations, and places of worship all over the earth with intercessory worship that reflects the worth of Jesus and releases the power of God.

School of MEDIA

Equipping media messengers with solid biblical training and media skills and tools to reach this generation

Forerunner Media Institute raises up modern-day scribes, like Ezra, to record, document, and broadcast what the Lord is doing throughout the earth.

We are committed to training these media messengers—ones burning with the forerunner message, who have a media anointing to fashion and produce content to proclaim the Word of the Lord to the nations.

School of MISSIONS

Preparing young adults for world missions: biblical training and a three-month placement in a challenging and remote part of the world

Antioch Center for Training and Sending (ACTS) is a six-month training program designed to equip 18–30-year-olds to walk in the power of the Holy Spirit and to partner with indigenous leaders, through worship, prayer, and courageous missions. We seek to help finish the task of the Great Commission. ACTS is committed to blazing a path for a culture of prayer.

STUDY IN CHINESE OR KOREAN AT IHOPU

IHOPU is delighted to announce two new programs in the Forerunner School of Ministry, which will begin in August 2013.

IHOPU already welcomes international students to come and study in English. In 2013 we will begin training in other languages, initially Chinese (Mandarin) and Korean. We will begin with a one-year program in August 2013, and will extend to four years of study at a later time.

ABOUT OUR FIVE INTERNSHIPS

The International House of Prayer internships exist to see this generation filled with the Word of God, ministering in the power of the Holy Spirit, fiery in intercession, and committed to outreach and service.

While each internship has a distinctive age group, length, and schedule, they all share the same central training components: corporate prayer and worship, classroom instruction, practical ministry experience, service and outreach, and the chance to be involved on worship teams.

Our five internships are three or six months long and accommodate all seasons of life. The purpose of all five programs is to further prepare individuals of all ages as intercessors, worshipers, messengers, singers, and musicians for the growing worship, prayer, and missions movement throughout the nations of the earth.

Biblical training in all the internships focuses on intimacy with Jesus, ministry in the power of the Holy Spirit, the forerunner ministry, evangelizing the lost, justice, and outreach. Interns also receive practical, hands-on training in prophetic and healing ministry.



FIRE IN THE NIGHT

Two three-month residential tracks for young adults, ages 18–30, who cry out to the Lord between the hours of midnight and 6:00am.

Ages 18–30 | 3 months per track



ONE THING INTERNSHIP

A six-month residential program for single young adults, ages 18 to 25.

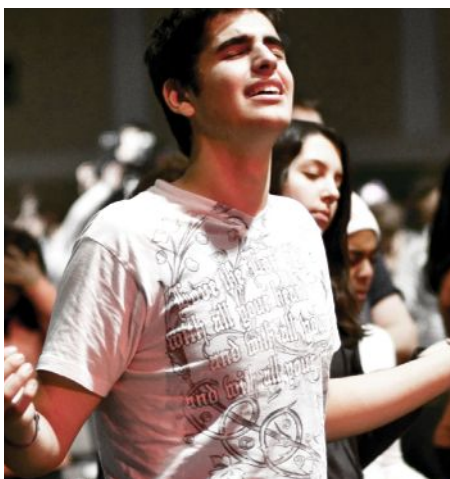

MY HOUSE SHALL BE CALLED A HOUSE OF PRAYER

The house of prayer in a city is not a church, not a prayer ministry, and not the building in which people meet. It is the whole body of Christ in that city. The International House of Prayer is only a “gas station”—we take a cup of gasoline and throw it on the prayer fires that burn in the real “house of prayer in Kansas City,” which is made up of more than 1,000 congregations in our area.

The eternal destiny of all God’s people is to function as a house of prayer now and in the age to come. Our greatest place of authority, honor, dignity, and security is found in the realm of prayer. It is not about having prayer meetings, but about establishing a prayer culture in the Body of Christ. In one short statement, Jesus revealed to us the eternal identity and destiny of His people. Jesus prophetically declared, “You shall be called a house of prayer.”

“He said to them, ‘It is written, “My house shall be called a house of prayer.”’” (Mt. 21:13)

Isaiah also spoke this decree when he prophesied to Israel: “My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations” (Isa. 56:7). When God calls us by a specific name, it indicates our character and how we are to function in the Holy Spirit.

What does it mean to be a house of prayer? It means that God speaks to us and moves our heart; then we speak those very words back to Him and it moves His heart. This results in God’s resources—His power, money, wisdom, creative ideas, unity, and favor in ministry—being released into the earthly realm. Yes, the foundational principle of prayer is that God speaks and moves our heart, and then we speak and move His heart. This is how God’s family will operate forever.

MYSTERY AND MAJESTY OF INTERCESSION

As we consider our identity as God’s house of prayer, I am struck by the mystery and the majesty of intercession. The mystery of intercession is in its simplicity: we just tell God what He tells

us to tell Him. It is so easy that everyone can do it. The majesty of intercession is that Jesus Himself intercedes. Jesus lives forever to make intercession for His people (Heb. 7:25); He rules the nations through intercession now and will do the same in the age to come (Ps. 2:8). Jesus is fully God, yet He intercedes. What humility!

In Genesis 1 the Father’s plan was to bring order to earth. The Spirit hovered over the earth, yet the chaos and darkness remained:

“The earth was without form, and void... and the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. Then God [Jesus] said, “Let there be light”; and there was light.” (Gen. 1:2–3)

When Jesus declared, “Let there be light,” the Spirit released light. The Spirit would not release the light until Jesus declared the word. The darkness remained until Jesus “interceded,” and spoke God’s word over the darkness to release the Spirit’s creative power.

All three members of the Godhead work together in creation. The Father's plan was to create the heavens and earth. Jesus spoke those plans into being. Jesus operated in the foundational principle of intercession by speaking God's word back to Him. Then the Holy Spirit released the power (Gen. 1:3, 9, 11, 14-15, 24, 30). Jesus expressed Himself as an "intercessory oracle," as Creator, by speaking God's Word back to God:

"By the word of the LORD the heavens were made, and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth." (Ps. 33:6)

Just as Jesus created all that is by speaking the word to the Father, He now upholds—holds together—the created order by the word of His power (Col. 1:17; Heb. 1:3). This is one form of intercession that Jesus will engage in forever.

PRAYER IS AGREEMENT

Agreement with God's heart is foundational to prayer and spiritual warfare and is expressed in worship. For example, we may say to God, "You are worthy," "You are good," or "Holy is the Lord." In worship, we declare the truth of who God is, and this leads to intimacy with Him.

Intercession is agreement with what God promises to do. For example, we may say, "Lord, release Your power." When we declare the truth of who God is in worship, our faith expands to agree with what He has promised to do—this is intercession.

The Father has ordained that His "house" rule with Jesus through "intimacy-based intercession." Intimacy refers to how our heart connects with God. Intercession relates to releasing His resources.

So we see that God governs the universe in partnership with His people through intercession. He opens doors of blessing and closes doors of oppression in response to our prayers. The Lord gives His people a dynamic role in determining a measure of the quality of life that we experience, as we respond to Him in prayer, obedience, faith, and meekness. There are blessings that God has chosen to give, but only as His people rise up in the partnership of prayer. He requires that we ask, because it causes us to interact with His heart (Jas. 4:2). This is an expression of His desire for intimate partnership with us.

God jealously protects His relationship with us by not releasing His resources until we speak to Him in prayer. He requires us to pray, for the very reason that He is jealous for relationship with us and is zealous to establish His goodness in our lives. God longs to release His grace and power, but waits until He hears the cry of His people in intercession (Isa. 30:18-19). God will not do our part, and we cannot do His part. If we don't do our part, then God withholds some of the help and blessing He would have given us.

JUSTICE

Jesus is the ultimate social reformer. He establishes justice to reform society. In Luke's gospel, Jesus said, "Will not God bring about justice for His elect who cry to Him day and night?" (Lk. 18:7-8, NASB). Jesus is the only social reformer in history who linked cultural transformation to night-and-day prayer.

Justice is exemplified by soul-winning, healing, revival, unity, the transformation of society. More than preventing wicked people from oppressing others, it includes empowering God's people. Jesus knew that prayer would deal with the spiritual issues related to injustice, and that prayer could change the spiritual atmosphere of a city or region.

Jesus continues in verse 8 (ESV): "He will give justice to them speedily." The only way justice can be fully manifest is

if we deal with the demonic powers in the supernatural realm, moving angels and demons by our words (Dan. 10:12-13). That is what Jesus' question means in verse 7. The missions movement can only go so far without night-and-day prayer.

INTERCESSION AND GOD'S PLAN

Prayer has always been at the center of

God's purpose. Chapters 4 and 5 of the book of Revelation describe the order of worship around God's throne, where the four living creatures agree with Him in 24/7 worship and intercession (Rev. 4:8).

Consider these examples: human history began in a praying meeting in the garden of Eden as Adam walked with God in the cool of the morning (Gen. 3:8); Israel as a nation began at a prayer meeting at Mount Sinai right after they crossed the Red Sea, when God called Israel to be a kingdom of priests (Ex. 19:6-20). The first mandate God gave them was to build a worship sanctuary, a house of prayer, in the wilderness (Ex. 25).

God's purpose for His people to be a house of prayer is evident during the reigns of David and his son Solomon—Israel's greatest hour in history. King David established night-and-day worship (1 Chr. 15-16) and paid more than 4,000 full-time paid musicians and singers (1 Chr. 23:5; 25:7). David commanded the kings and leaders in the generations after him to establish and maintain worship in the way that God had revealed to him (2 Chr. 29:25; 35:4, 15; Ezra 3:10; Neh. 12:45).

Zerubbabel established full-time singers and musicians as commanded by David (Ezra 3:10-11; Neh. 12:47). Ezra and Nehemiah did the same (Neh. 12:24, 45). Each time this order of worship was reintroduced in Israel, spiritual breakthrough, deliverance, and military victory followed.

Jesus Himself began His public ministry in a prayer meeting in the wilderness (Mt. 4) and ended it in a prayer meeting in the garden of Gethsemane (Mt. 26). The church began in a prayer meeting (Acts 1-2). Natural history as we know it will end in the context of a global prayer movement. The conflict at the end of the age will be between two houses of prayer, two global worship movements. The Holy Spirit is raising up the most powerful worship movement in history (Rev. 22:17; 5:8; 8:4; Lk. 18:7-8; Isa. 62:6-7; 24:14-16; 25:9; 26:8-9; 30:18-19; 42:10-13). It will totally defeat the Antichrist's end-time, worldwide, false worship movement (Rev. 13:8).

Before Jesus returns, the Spirit-anointed Church across the nations, established in her bridal identity and functioning in intercession and worship, will cry out with the Spirit, "Come, Lord Jesus!" (Rev. 22:17).

JESUS, OUR BRIDEGROOM GOD

Likewise, Jesus is longing for His Bride. God's ultimate purpose for His creation is to provide a family for Himself and

a bride for His Son, a bride who will reign forever with Him as His eternal companion. John heard the glorious announcement in heaven to rejoice because the marriage of the Lamb had come and because Jesus' wife had made herself ready (Rev. 19:7-9). Yes, natural history will end with a great wedding celebration. One of the guiding principles of the Father's activity throughout all of history has been to prepare a bride for His worthy Son, to train a bride to rule the earth as Jesus' eternal companion (Rev. 3:21; 5:10).

As women are called to be sons of God, so men are called to part of the Bride of Christ. Both describe a position of great privilege before God for the redeemed. These privileges do not point to something that is intrinsically male or female; they transcend gender (Gal. 3:28). As sons of God, we are in a position to experience God's throne as heirs of His power. As the Bride of Christ, we are in a position to experience God's heart, His deep desire for us.

Men often struggle with the idea of being the Bride of Christ, because they wrongly conclude that it is a call to become less masculine. Experiencing the truth of the Bride of Christ does not undermine a man's masculinity, but rather strengthens it. God created us to be wholehearted lovers of God forever.

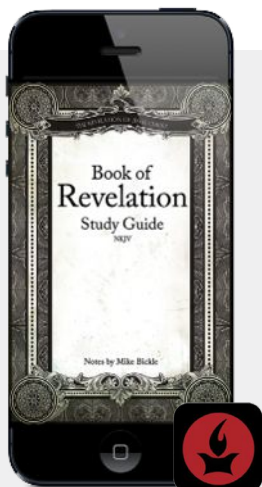
Some of the greatest men of God functioned in the spiritual reality that comes

to fullness in being the Bride of Christ. King David was Israel's greatest warrior king, yet he was a worshiper, ravished by God's desire for him and fascinated by His beauty (Ps. 27:4).

John prophesied a time when the Spirit and the Bride would say, "Come, Lord Jesus!" (Rev. 22:17, 20). John's prophecy describes the Church, in unity with the Spirit, saying and doing what the Spirit is saying and doing. For the first time in history, the Spirit will emphasize the Church's spiritual identity as Jesus' bride in every nation. Notice that John does not say that the Spirit and the family will say, "Come!" nor the Spirit and the army, nor the kingdom, nor the Body, nor the priesthood. It is the Spirit and the Bride, in full unity, crying out for Jesus to return. We will rejoice forever in our spiritual identity as the Body of Christ and the family of God.

Jesus is not coming back to a prayerless Church, but to a people enjoying mature bridal partnership with Him in intercession for the harvest. The Church will not fail in the task of preaching the gospel to the ends of the earth; God's people will complete the Great Commission, reaching all nations in the power of the Holy Spirit (Mt. 24:14). When Jesus returns, He is coming to take His Bride to Himself, a bride who will be on fire with passion for Him (Rev. 22:17).

The Church will see Jesus as her Bridegroom God. He is our Savior, but He is

more than a savior. He is our Healer, but more than a healer. He is the Captain of the armies of heaven, but He is more than that. He is a Bridegroom filled with desire for His people and He is longing for partnership with them.

Simply put, the revelation of Jesus as the Bridegroom is the revelation of Jesus' burning desire for His people. As the Bride of Christ, we are to walk in revelation of Jesus' emotions for us, to understand and rejoice in His commitment to share His heart with us, and to respond with wholehearted love and obedience to His will as we enter into partnership with Him. (We refuse all sensual overtones in the Bride of Christ message).

God reveals Himself in intimate relationship with His people throughout the Scriptures. Examples include:

- Hosea prophesied that God's people would one day call the Messiah their "Husband," no longer their "Taskmaster" (Hos. 2:16).

- Isaiah described God rejoicing over His people as a bridegroom rejoices over a bride (Isa. 62:4-5).
- Jesus introduced Himself at the beginning of His ministry as a bridegroom (Mt. 9:15). As a king, He reveals His great power; as a bridegroom, He shows His burning desire for His people.
- John the Baptist spoke of Jesus as the Bridegroom (Jn. 3:29).
- Jesus ended His public ministry, declaring that the kingdom of God is like the Father arranging a wedding for His Son (Mt. 22:2).
- The New Jerusalem is called "the bride" (Rev. 21:9-10), named for the people for whom it is prepared and who will rule the earth from that great city (Rev. 19:7; 21:2; 22:17). There, the redeemed will experience a face-to-face, intimate relationship with Jesus, their Bridegroom God (Rev. 22:4).

On that great day when we shall see Him face to face, the Lamb will take His Bride

to His Father's home to be with Him forever. In this time of betrothal preceding the wedding of Bride and Bridegroom, God intends that we should experience intimacy with His heart through prayer. As we grow in our knowledge and experience of the Father's tender mercy and Jesus' fiery desire for us, our prayer life is energized and transformed.

Burnout is a problem today. Many fiery intercessors from the '80s and '90s have lost the freshness of intercession. God wants to restore the "oil of intimacy," and yearns for us to know and experience Jesus as God the Bridegroom.

This is foundational for the Church in her quest to function in her spiritual identity as a house of prayer (Isa. 56:7). And so the Lord is restoring those who are burned out—He is energizing His beloved Church with intimacy with Jesus, the Bridegroom God. Let us all hear what the Spirit is saying to the Church, as we learn to cry, with a bride's heart, "Come, Lord Jesus!" 🙌



CHILDREN *IN THE KINGDOM*

Few of us would say that children can't hear God's voice, or pray, or impact others, yet our children's ministries often reflect a default view of kids as "junior Christians" with a "junior Holy Spirit," who requires very little of them except that they "be good" and enjoy themselves. Our view of children's ministry as primarily a babysitting service needs to be challenged, because a child can be every inch a Christian as his or her father, mother, or Sunday school teacher. More than simply ensuring that children have proper supervision or stay entertained while their parents attend service, our goal as leaders must be to create an environment in which children learn to preach, teach, prophesy, and develop a heart to see the sick healed and the lost saved.

We all agree that the heat of the battle against the family and the church is intensifying. Our children are bombarded with many things that distract them from pursuing a personal and ongoing relationship with Jesus. It is no surprise that many kids grow up without a vision for the power and ministry of the Holy Spirit. Yet, they are very much capable of knowing God in a deep way, and that is God's desire for them.

In view of the cultural and spiritual barriers to children's growth in God, as well as His high calling for them, we need to change our approach to children's ministry. Nothing less than a paradigm shift will suffice. We must confront the patterns of decades and search for divine strategies to empower children to live in wholehearted devotion to Jesus.

It's as critical as developing strategies or formulas for any other aspect of church growth.

THREE QUESTIONS WE ASK OURSELVES

As we look our situation squarely in the face, and anticipate the second coming of Jesus, let's ask ourselves the following questions.

How then shall we lead?

- Let's devote ourselves to fervent prayer for "understanding of the times" (1 Chr. 12:32) and courage to implement divine strategies.
- Let's expand our focus beyond the adults. In most of our churches, we emphasize reaching and teaching adults. Since adults are more developed intellectually, financially, and socially, we easily see them as being more important to the work of the ministry than children. Nothing could be farther from the truth.
- Let's help children in our churches to live in obedience to the Word of God. Children need spiritual discernment to identify counterfeit saviors and to choose to follow Jesus no matter what the cost. How we train our children now will assist them to live for God as they walk through the difficult days ahead.

What then shall we teach?

- Let's not grasp at straws. Rather than jumping quickly on the next best program or curriculum, we can trust in what God is revealing to us. He


has entrusted this generation to our leadership, and He is able to help us bring them up.

- Let's remember who these children are. Our children can receive revelation in the Word, hear the voice of the Lord, and experience the power of the Holy Spirit. There is no toddler, pre-school, or junior Holy Spirit. When we remember this, we teach children in an age-appropriate way, without watering down the gospel or exempting them from kingdom life.

What songs shall we sing?

- Let's create a culture of praise and worship for our children's services with the same care and passion with which we plan our adult services.
- Let's train children to lead worship. We can add to the job description of our worship leaders the task of recruiting, training, and deploying both adults and kids to lead praise and worship specifically for children's gatherings.
- Let's become childlike, not childish. Jesus said we must receive the kingdom of God "as a little child" in order to enter it (Lk. 18: 17). What did He see in them? How did He feel about them? Let's not "grow" our kids "out of" childlikeness.

May the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord be passed on to this generation and generations to follow!

"...telling to the generation to come the praises of the LORD, and His strength and His wonderful works that He has done." (Ps. 78:4)

At the very core of the Children's Equipping Center is our mandate to establish a culture that equips and releases children to be devoted and wholehearted before God.

- The prophetic: We teach children to believe the promise given to us in Acts 2:17 that in these days His Spirit will be poured out on all flesh and that they can receive the Holy Spirit's ministry. ✨

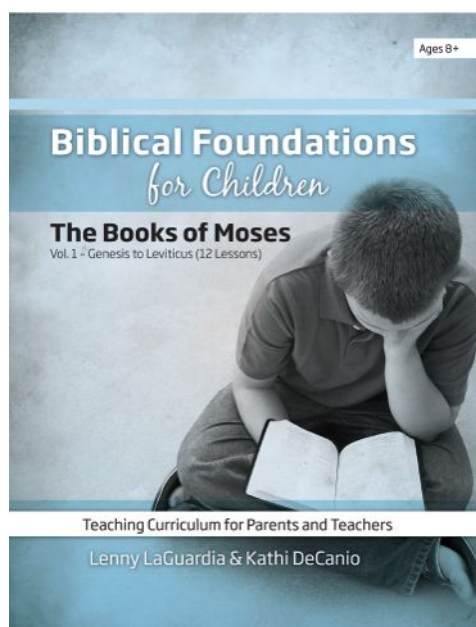



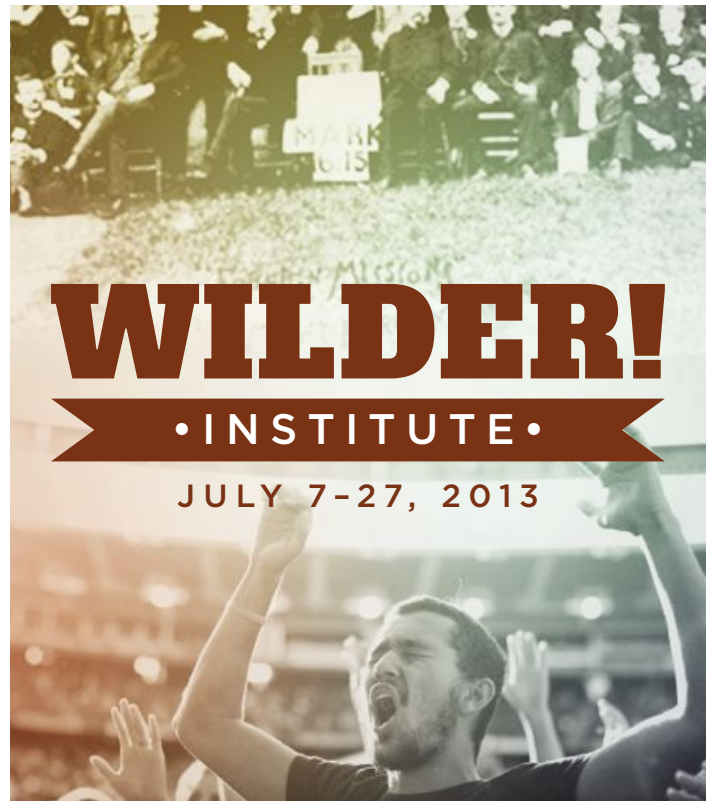

MUSIC & THE GLOBAL WORSHIP MOVEMENT

BY MISTY EDWARDS

*I*t doesn't take a prophet to see that the earth is in a crisis, and it doesn't take a pessimist to see that much of the Church is lukewarm. Yet it is in this environment that the Lord is raising up a worldwide movement of prayer and worship. In an hour of confusion, as chaos grows and darkness deepens, the Lord is awakening the dawn of a new day (Isa. 24:15). It includes songs of worship in this dark night; it is a global house of worship made up of the entire Body of Christ.

But the day will not dawn without conflict. The battle at the end of the age will for the passion of man, a war between two worship movements. Even now Satan is assaulting the cultures of the earth in a demonic campaign to raise up a false worldwide worship movement (Rev. 13:4, 8, 15). He is enticing people to worship themselves, which will lead them to worship him.

But Jesus also has a plan in His heart, and His will not fail. Around the globe, young people are catching a glimpse of the beauty and worth of Jesus and how He is worshiped in heaven. As they begin to understand the governmental authority they have in intercession, they are taking their rightful place in the kingdom and will bring a multitude with them to the throne of grace.

This is a sign of the times, the beginning of the fulfillment of Isaiah's prophesy that in the last days a song would be heard from the ends of the earth (Isa. 24:14-16; 26:1; 27:2; 30:29, 32; 35:2, 10; 42:10-12; 54:1).

MORE THAN A SONG

This worldwide song will usher in the second coming of Jesus (Isa. 42:10-14). More than a song, it is a movement of prayer, of intercession—it is a cry for justice to prevail in every sphere of life.

The many strands of the tapestry of this prayer and worship movement are beautiful and precious in the heart of God. I am going to focus on the centrality of worship.

The cause of much of the crisis we are facing is that humankind has forsaken its primary purpose—to love God with all of our heart, soul, mind, and strength (Deut. 6:5; Mt. 22:37). The crisis in society is meant to wake us up so that we turn to God and bring the lost to Him. But even salvation is not the end of the story; worship is.

Worship is a vast subject, involving our reaction to God and our relationship with Him. I am often asked how I keep Jesus in the center of my worship. I am perplexed by the question, because if Jesus is not in the center, what we are doing is not worship, it is "just music." Worship is a response to something

that we see and to Someone we adore. In order for the worship movement to be more than a festival of good music, singers and musicians must grow in the knowledge of God above all else.

We cannot lead people where we are not going. As leaders of worship we must actually worship; to worship, we must see; and to see, we have to know the Word of God.

The Church and the world has had its fair share of flaky musicians, but the Lord is gathering an army of young adults who, like King David, will have a heart after God—hearts that will search the Scriptures and be well acquainted with the Spirit. Through an army with such a heart, worship will explode around the globe.

The significance of music itself in this worship movement cannot be underestimated. Music is one of the most powerful realities of the human existence, because the human spirit is musical.

Music has the ability to touch the deepest part of us, simultaneously focusing the mind, spirit, and emotions. Melody and rhythm write truth, or lies, on the heart, as if programming a computer, so to speak. We have a much better chance of remembering something if we set it to music. God knows this about our human design because He created us this way.

I believe He designed us for music because He Himself is musical.

THE WORD AND MUSIC: A POWERFUL COMBINATION

If music helps people “feel” the truth and remember it, what power there is when the Word is combined with music! You can speak about God’s personality and people will be touched, but if you sing that same truth with anointed, prophetic music, people will feel the truth and understand and remember it, because they will wake up the next morning singing it. In this worship movement, Jesus is raising up theologians who know the Word of God, who sing and have the tongue of a ready writer, ready to describe Him (Ps. 45:1).

Music is a universal language. It is instinctive. Every culture has a musical expression that brings people together. Music has the power to unify a group

of people. The best way to get an entire stadium of people saying the same thing, feeling the same thing, talking to the same Man at the same time is through music. As we lift our voices in song, we become one voice and one heart, standing before Jesus in adoration. Individually, we may have our eyes closed in a worship service, gazing on Jesus, singing straight to Him, yet corporately we become one body.

ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN

Worship is a mysterious reality, and we have yet to fully understand its mystery as it relates to the Bride of Christ. Revelation chapters 4 and 5 describe the worship order around God's throne: those nearest to Him agree with Him in 24/7 worship and intercession. People from every tongue, tribe, nation, and people group will join the angels around the throne, on the sea of glass, declaring the worth of Jesus in proclamation, music, and song. Though there will be different tongues and languages, the truth is the same, the heart of worship is the same, and the same Man is being adored. Thus, we will truly be one Bride before God's throne—one Bride with different cultural expressions, made up of the fiery hearts of love of individual believers. Worship will be offered "on earth as it is in heaven" (Mt. 6:10).

Worship is a doorway to the prophetic, connecting us with the heart of God. The writer of Hebrews describes Jesus standing in the congregation singing praise to the Father and declaring His name (Heb. 2:12). One specific way that He does this is through us, His people, as we declare God's praise. As we stand before Him in adoration, powerful declarations of truth can come forth in worship settings: through the Word and the Spirit we hear his thoughts and sing them over congregations, over the nations, over our circumstances. The spirit of prophecy will be seen on singers, songwriters, and musicians as we continue to come before Him day and night. It becomes a perpetual conversation with God, through His Word, by His Spirit.



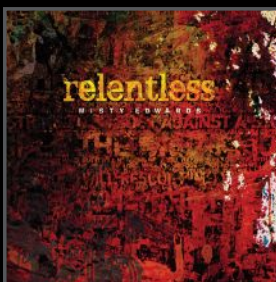
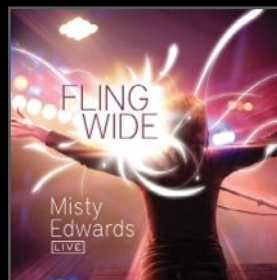

The anointing of the Spirit on our worship music tenderizes our hearts, increasing our desire to love Jesus and our ability to actually feel love for Him. At the same time, we are empowered to do good works as the anointing to love Him sustains our hearts in our acts of service.

As darkness deepens and the great shaking comes to the whole earth, people will be looking for answers. The beauty of Jesus, declared through true worship, will be a key to bring understanding, comfort, and love to a people seeking truth in the midst of chaos.

Two worship movements are being raised up, one born in darkness, the other in light. Satan is working aggressively, elevating gifted artists in an attempt to build his own counterfeit end-time worship movement, but God is sovereign and some of the young musicians who once dreamed of becoming famous “rock stars” are being persuaded, by God, to join the true

worship movement. It is exciting to see Satan’s investments in the youth of the nations being snatched from him for the glory and adoration of Jesus!

At the end of the age, the beauty of Jesus will be stronger than the allure of self-promotion and sensual pleasure. Jesus’ worship movement will be stronger, more creative, and more anointed than anything that Satan can vomit from the pit of hell. The battle is real, but Jesus will win the hearts and the passion of many in the generation before His return.

Jesus, our magnificent obsession, the eternal King, the Lamb, will receive the worship due to His name. The Branch of the Lord will be seen as beautiful and glorious and He will win the hearts of a generation (Isa. 4:2).

Let the song arise. To the end! 🕊

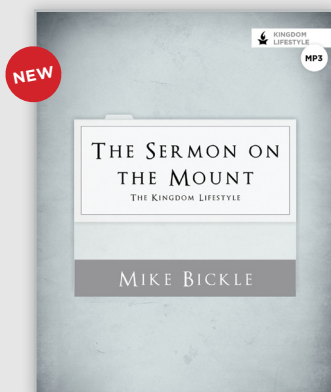

ZECHARIAH: STUDIES IN THE END TIMES

This verse-by-verse study of Zechariah was given in 12 sessions by Mike Bickle. Zechariah is considered one of the most important prophetic books in the Bible. It contains some of the most specific information for the Church concerning events which will occur in Jerusalem and the nations just before Jesus returns.
